



### ▶ Via WA-99

(from the North)

- 1. Follow WA-99 S
- 2. Take exit toward Harbor Island from WA-99 S
- 3. Take SW Spokane St Bridge to Manning St/ SW Spokane St
- 4. Turn right into Harley Marine driveway

## ▶ Via I-5

(from the North or South)

- 1. Take I-5 N/S toward Seattle
- 2. Take exit 163 for W Seattle Bridge
- 3. Merge onto Spokane St Viaduct/ West Seattle Bridge

## ▶ Via WA-99/WA-509/E Marginal Way

(from the South)

- 1. Follow WA-99/WA-509 N, continue onto E Marginal Way S
- 2. Take exit toward Spokane St/W Seattle, continue on E Marginal Way S
- 3. Turn left onto S Spokane St, continue onto SW
- 4. Turn right into Harley Marine driveway
- 4. Take exit 18 toward Harbor Island/11th Ave SW
- **5.** Continue straight onto SW Spokane St Bridge/
- **6.** At the bottom of ramp, turn right into Harley Marine driveway
