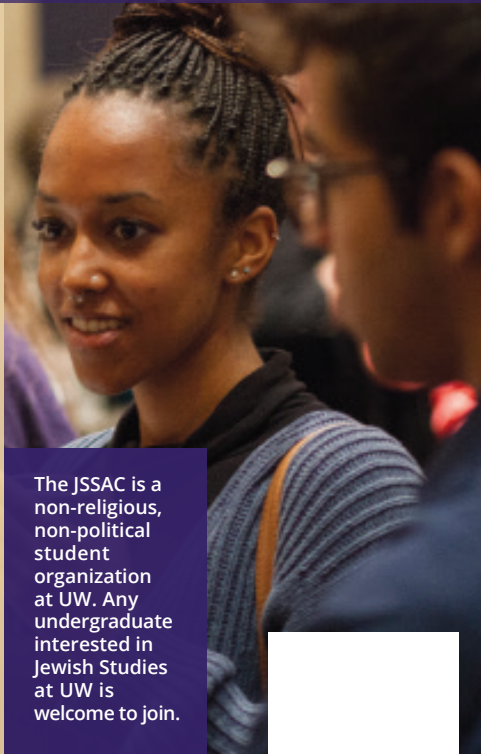




JOIN THE JEWISH STUDIES STUDENT ADVISORY COUNCIL
